Bakersfield Museum of Art Draws Internationally Known and Local Artists to Spring Fundraiser

(Bakersfield, CA) – March 4, 2022 – Local and Internationally known artists will gather at the Bakersfield Museum of Art for its annual fundraiser ARTMIX, a curated cocktail party benefiting the Bakersfield Museum of Art, on Thursday, March 31, 2022, at 7:00 PM.

At ARTMIX, guests enjoy an off-the-wall art sale featuring work by local and regional artists. Priced from \$100-\$400, pieces are sold on a first-come, first-served basis. The evening also includes a silent auction of works by artists featured in BMoA's current exhibition *On the Edge: Los Angeles Art, 1970s – 1990s, from the Joan and Jack Quinn Family Collection*. Silent auction artists include Larry Bell, Tony Berlant, Woods Davy, Laddie John Dill, Ned Evans, Joe Fay, Chris Hartunian, EF Kitchen, Gwynn Murrill, and Astrid Preston.

ARTMIX also features sophisticated bites and signature cocktails crafted by Bakersfield eateries, including Aunt Mae's Sweet Tooth, Baker's Outpost, Bord a Petite, Campo Bar + Bottle, The Kitchen, Locale Farm to Table, Luigi's Italian Restaurant and Delicatessen, Montoya Vineyards, Moo Creamery, Nuestro Mexico Restaurant, and Voktail.

Guests can also purchase opportunity draw (raffle) tickets for a chance to win one of three commissioned portraits by *On the Edge* exhibiting artist Joe Fay (a \$700 value).

At the ARTMIX benefactor reception, guests get a first opportunity to view and buy objects for sale during an exclusive champagne reception. The benefactor reception begins at 5:30 PM.

Music for the evening will be provided by local DJs Cat and DJ Chuck One. Creative, colorful cocktail attire is encouraged. Guests will be welcomed at BMoA's sculpture garden entrance at 19th and R Street.

Proceeds from ARTMIX benefit the BMoA Fund, which supports all areas of the Museum including preservation of the BMoA permanent collection, visiting exhibitions, and youth art education and outreach.
